THE AWARDS

Question: Why an awards program?

Answer: Automation Anywhere is all about people. Our customers and partners are valued members of our extended family, who contribute to our success. We want to celebrate the great work and amazing collaboration that happens throughout our ecosystem with a number of different awards meaningful to our culture, technology and industry.

Question: Who can be nominated?

Answer: Automation Anywhere customers and partners—as specified in each award entry form.

Question: Who can submit nominations for consideration?

Answer: Automation Anywhere customers and partners—as specified in each award entry form

Question: What are the benefits of winning an award?

Answer: Many!

- Gain international peer recognition in the AI and RPA fields;
- Develop the reputation of your team and your company;
- Discover speaking and publishing opportunities;
- Build your personal reputation as a thought leader;
- Inspire and thank the people you work with, both inside and outside your company;
- Challenge yourself to greater heights of excellence;
- Get validation from one of the most innovative RPA companies in around the world.

Winners will receive social media badges, certificates and trophies that they may use to share their wins with their employees, customers, friends and followers.

Question: Is there a nomination or entry fee?

Answer: No

Question: Where can I find a list of past winners for the various awards?

Answer: This is the first year of the awards. After our very first winners are announced (by May 20, 2021), we will post a winners' page on our Automation Anywhere Awards site.

THE NOMINATION FORMS

Question: How do I edit/fill out the nomination form?

Answer: You must download the pdf file to your desktop and open the file in Acrobat Reader.

Question: Can I edit the nomination form in my browser?



Answer: No, you must download the pdf file to your desktop and open the file in Acrobat Reader.

Question: Why can't I attach a file to the nomination form?

Answer: You need to use Acrobat Reader to fill out the form. This will allow you to attach files.

Question: What kinds of files can I attach in the nomination form?

Answer: All Microsoft Office, jpg, tiff, png.

Question: Why won't the submit button work?

Answer: You need to use Acrobat Reader to fill out the form and submit the form.

Question: Can I email the nomination form instead of using the submit button?

Answer: Yes, simply complete the form and email it to brandcouncil@automationanywhere.com

Question: By when should I submit my nominations?

Answer: Submission dates will be posted on the awards site for customers and partners.

Question: Do I have to upload an image as part of my entry?

Answer: We ask all winners to provide a photo and company logo that represents their winning entry. This image may be used represent your entry in any promotion or publicity of winners.

Question: How do I know if my entry has been received?

Answer: You will receive a confirmation email after you have sent your nomination.

ANSWERING THE NOMINATION QUESTIONS

Question: What time span should I consider when answering these nomination questions?

Answer: The nomination should describe achievements of the nominee at any time between February 2020 and March 2021.

Question: How many different nominations can I submit for an award? Is there a limit?

Answer: As many as you like. There is no limit.

Question: Can I nominate the same person or team for different awards?

Answer: Yes, as long as their achievements and other qualifications meet the other awards' requirements.

Question: Can I really nominate myself for an award?

Answer: Yes, as long as self-nomination is specified as an option in that particular award form.

Question: If I am nominating a team, whose name and contact info do I enter as the "team contact?"



Answer: The team contact should ideally be the person, or one of the people, who was principally responsible for the development, management and execution of the primary achievement the nomination describes. If the nominator is a member of the team, and the award allows self-nominating, it may be that you, the nominator, are the ideal team contact.

ANONYMITY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

Question: Do the nominations remain confidential?

Answer: No, we cannot ensure that only assigned judges will review entries, and that information about nominees is not released to anyone else without prior approval.

Question: Can a nomination be made anonymously?

Answer: No

WINNING AN AWARD

Question: How are winners notified and recognized?

Answer: Check our website for the most recent notification dates.

Question: How will all other members of a winning team, beyond the team contact, get credit on the winners' website, recognition, certificates and badges?

Answer: After a winning team is announced, the team contact will be asked to provide AAI with all team members' names so they can be recognized on the winners' website and receive certificates and badges.

Question: How do I ensure all other members of a winning team as well as the named team contact get trophies for working on the project?

Answer: If a team wins, the team contact may provide the names of all team members over email. Each winning team entry eligible for a trophy (not all awards categories award trophies) automatically receives one trophy with the team name.

AWARDS JUDGING

Question: How are winners determined?

Answer: Answer to each {awards name} nomination question is read and scored separately by two independent judges on our panel using a five-point global scale of excellence (1-5) as a guide. These are averaged for one overall score. The judges conduct blind readings with name of nominator, nominee, email addresses and company name redacted. General guidelines are as follows and these are further customized for the judges of each award:

- A "5" demonstrates extraordinary, deep and insightful thinking; takes all aspects of any challenge into account and shows significant results that go above and beyond;



- A “4” shows an innovative, strategic approach; takes all elements of a challenge into account and delivers meaningful results answering the business need;
- A “3” is a fully completed answer with a solid success story and results;
- A “2” means one or more key elements that are critical to answering the nomination questions are missing, incorrect or weak;
- A “1” means the nomination does not describe a viable approach and/or does not include meaningful results.

Question: Will you share the overall score of my nomination with me?

Answer: No. We also will not share the overall score of nominations with anyone outside our awards program managers and judging panel.

Question: How are the judges selected?

Answer: The two judges who read and score each entry are AAI leaders chosen for their expertise in the nomination’s specific award category.
